



I have had a lovely break away and was lucky enough to catch up with many of my family before Christmas and Kev and I enjoyed three days on an Avocado Orchard which friends of ours have recently purchased in Katikati.

While away it became clear that we will move into the traffic light system on Friday 3rd December. This means that on the weekend of the 4th and 5th December we will be in either the red or orange traffic light system.

IF WE ARE IN RED:

There will be the Saturday 6pm Vigil Mass and the 9:30am Sunday Mass. These Masses will require a vaccine pass and there is a limit of 100 people. YOU MUST REGISTER FOR THESE MASSES THROUGH THE ADW WEBSITE.

On Saturday at 4pm there will be a Mass which does not require a vaccine pass. This mass will be limited to 10 people, and you must register for this (at this stage) through the Parish office. Email st.theresas@xtra.co.nz

IF WE ARE IN ORANGE:

There will be the 6pm Vigil Mass and the 9:30am Mass. These Masses will require a vaccine pass and there will be no restrictions on numbers.

On Saturday at 4pm there will be a Mass which does not require a vaccine pass. There is a limit of 50 for this mass and you must register for this through the office. Email st.theresas@xtra.co.nz.

This is a very difficult time for everyone, and compassion, empathy, understanding and patience are needed as we navigate through this new way of life. Everyone is doing their best no matter what decision they have made regarding the vaccine and we hope that with the options available to you at each of the traffic light stages, you will continue to feel welcome at our parish.


